Kyle Mulhall brings 25 years of experience in legislative affairs, and administrative, transportation and environmental law. Kyle joined Gephardt Government Affairs as a Vice President in April 2010, where he currently oversees many of the firm's aviation, municipal, maritime, surface transportation, and technology clients on a full scope federal policy and related appropriations issues.

Kyle served as Senior Policy Advisor for transportation, energy, agriculture and environmental policy to House Democratic Leader Dick Gephardt from 1995 to 2003. In that position, Kyle coordinated policy for House Democrats; drafting legislation, policy white papers, and members' speeches and press statements.

Following the terrorist attacks of September 11, 2001, Kyle served as a lead negotiator on the Airline Stabilization Act and the later Aviation Security Act. He worked extensively on transit policy; highway planning and investment; and rail, truck and pipeline safety issues. Kyle was staff lead for the House Democratic Energy Taskforce, and authored their national energy plan in 2001. He also worked for tax incentives for renewable fuels and electric power, and conservation. Kyle promoted research in biotechnology and also has

extensive experience on clean air issues, climate change, Superfund and land and water conservation issues.

In addition to his national policy work, Kyle oversaw appropriations and major grant projects for Mr. Gephardt. Kyle worked with local leaders to achieve authorization and secure funding for a broad array of transportation and infrastructure projects ranging from job-training centers and small business incubators to airport expansion, among others.

Following his departure from Capitol Hill, Kyle served as General Counsel for a government contracting firm that specialized in working with federal transportation agencies, and later practiced transportation law with a 500 attorney firm.

Before his role in the House Democratic Leadership, Kyle served as an attorney for the U.S. Department of Transportation from 1989 to 1996, working with rail, freight shipping and environmental programs. Kyle worked on litigation for the District of Columbia from 1987 to 1988 and the Attorney General of Kentucky in 1985. He also served on the staff of U.S. Senator Walter D. Huddleston of Kentucky in 1984.

Kyle earned his juris doctorate from the George Washington University Law School in 1986 and his bachelor's in Political Science in 1983 from the University of Louisville. He is a member of the District of Columbia bar.
